Laura Volkman Vineyards is dedicated to growing premium fruit and producing hand-crafted wines that are true to the varietal and the vintage. “We let the fruit make the wine”. We believe severe pruning and low fruit yields produce wines with intense aromas and flavors. We micromanage the vineyard throughout the growing season and harvest only when the fruit has reached optimal aroma, flavor and color development.

Our Wines

2006 Rachel Estate Pinot Noir (\$38/bottle) Wine Spectator – 91 pts.

Our new pinot noir from our estate vineyard’s west block includes Pinot Clones 114, Pommard, and 667. The wine boasts of soft black cherry fruits and truffle with a hint of spice and smoke with a long cherry finish. **SOLD OUT.** 14.2% AL

2006 Jacob Estate Pinot Noir (\$42/bottle)

Our flagship wine from our estate vineyard’s east block includes Pinot Clones 777, 115 and a small amount of 114. The wine shows chocolate, and lavish black cherry all wrapped up in earthy aromatics and a long sweet finish. 14.4% AL

2007 Bella Chardonnay (\$25/bottle)

Aged in 50% french oak and 50% stainless steel, this wine is Chardonnay Wente Clone from the Columbia Gorge/Hood River. This wine shows pear and floral aromatics and rich viscosity (texture) along with a hint of residual sugar, (.6%). 13.8% AL

2007 Jacob Estate Pinot Noir (\$45/bottle)

During a cool growing season, pinot noir will develop intense phenolics (aromatics and flavors) which can carry over beautifully into the bottle. The 2007 vintage Jacob is a blend of clones 777, 115 and 114 and we feel it is a classic example of our vineyard’s terroir with an elegant blend of cherry and smoke on a long sweet finish. 13.5% AL

2007 Rachel Estate Pinot Noir (\$TBD)

Another classic example of our terroir; this wine is a blend of Pommard, 667 and 114 and as the old world clone of Pommard sometimes takes time to reveal itself, we are waiting to unveil her. 13.2% AL
